UGC-NET qualified with M.A. in Sanskrit with a minimum of 55% marks from any recognised University.

Desirable: Ph.D. in Sanskrit or any allied areas.

Consolidated payment of Rs.1500/- per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs.50,000/- per month, in case a Guest Faculty teaches two courses. 
