NOTIFICATION FOR RECRUITMENT OF AD-HOC FACULTY

The Department of Anthropology, University of Hyderabad, invites applications from eligible candidates for Ad-hoc appointment of **Two Assistant Professors (2-UR) purely on temporary basis in the pay scale of Assistant Professor** (UGC pre-revised VI Pay Scale) for teaching MA and/or IMA courses in Anthropology. **The appointment will be for the Monsoon semester only (August to December 2020).** Interested candidates may send their application addressed to Head, Department of Anthropology, University of Hyderabad, Hyderabad by e-mail (bvsss@uohyd.ernet.in & headanthropology@uohyd.ac.in) by 31st August, 2020. The applicants should attach all the relevant documents (CV and copies of certificates in support of their educational qualifications, publications and teaching experience and Community) along with the application.

Eligibility: A Master's degree with 55% marks in Anthropology with specialization in Social/Cultural Anthropology from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University. Other essential qualifications like clearance of NET will be as per the UGC's latest guidelines.

Desirable qualifications:

1. Ph.D. Degree in Anthropology
2. Publications in peer reviewed journals;
3. Teaching experience at Master's level; and
4. Experience in online teaching-learning

Mode of recruitment: The applications received will be scrutinized, and suitable candidates will be called for a colloquium and interview, which will be held online. The details of the colloquium and interview (i.e., date and time, link for the google meet for online presentations etc.) will be intimated to the shortlisted candidates by e-mail at least FIVE days before the interview. Each candidate will have to make a presentation (15-20 minutes) of their choice, on any one of the given topics for the colloquium from the following theories

Topics for presentations: 1. Anthropological theories of Diffusion; 2. Culture and Personality theories; 3. Neo-evolutionism; 4. Functionalism; 5. Structural-functionalism; 6. Structuralism; 7. Post-structuralism.

The University reserves the right to cancel the interviews without assigning any reason and also not to select any candidate, if none are found suitable. This appointment is purely temporary and can be terminated at any time without assigning any reason thereof.

The University will not be responsible if the candidates fail to attend the colloquium and interview due to any reason, including technical problems for online presentations/interview and will not consider holding interviews on subsequent dates. The candidates are hence advised to get acquainted with online meeting and make necessary preparations well in advance to avoid trouble shooting.

The colloquium and interviews are tentatively scheduled on 7th and 9th September, 2020.
