1. **Research Associate-I (1 post):** Monthly emoluments of Rs. 58000/- + 27% HRA as sanctioned in the project

Essential qualification : A PhD degree in Life Sciences, Botany, Biochemistry, Biotechnology and Plant sciences from a recognized University or equivalent

Desired qualifications : Proven research experience in plant molecular biology, NGS data analyses, knowledge on small RNA research as evidenced by two authored publications in a reputed journal

Age limit : As per the University/DBT norms

Please note:

1. The initial appointment will be for one year or until the tenability of the projects, whichever is earlier. The same can be curtailed/extended based on the candidates' performance.
2. The position is purely temporary, and the applicants will have no implicit or explicit claim for consideration against any regular position at the university.
3. Eligible candidates are encouraged to send their application to sribashroy@uohyd.ac.in with all the relevant documents against claims in the application form as a single PDF. The deadline to receive the application is **July 31, 2024 (5.30 pm)**.
4. Candidates must ascertain their eligibility before applying. Ineligible candidates will not be interviewed, and no further communication will be sent in case of disqualification. Information about the interview will be sent only to the shortlisted candidates.
5. No TA/DA will be provided to appear in an interview or at the time of joining
6. Eligible/shortlisted candidates will be informed at a later date
7. The shortlisted candidates will be called for the interview in hybrid mode.
