About the program

Online Seven Day International Research Methodology Course Workshop for M.Phil./Ph.D./PDF Research Scholars in social sciences will be instrumental in enriching the research scholars in understanding the relationships between concepts and themes in research and different tools of the methods of inquiry and critical research process from inter-disciplinary perspective in Social Sciences. The major effort of this course is to equip them with an inclusive understanding of both qualitative and quantitatively research methodology.

Objectives

1. To expose the participants to the diverse research methodologies in interdisciplinary research.
2. To assist the participants in selecting the suitable method (s) while conducting research.
3. To train the participants in using the quantitative methods and also qualitative research methods such as individual interviews, case study, focus group discussion, ethnography, non-participant and participant observation and the like.
4. To encourage and train the participants in the art of academic writing and publishing in reputed journals of Social Sciences.
5. To familiarize the participants with the E-resources and Digital Tools in academic writing.
6. To train the participants to do literature review.

Expected outcome of this Workshop

1. By the end of the workshop, the participants will learn how to formulate research questions, research design, be equipped to collect and analyse data leading to new insightful research findings.
2. Expose the participants to various research techniques and method/s to conduct interdisciplinary research
3. Participants acquiring ideational and practical understanding on and familiarity with interdisciplinary research
4. The conduct and practices of qualitative and quantitative research
5. The importance of academic publication and career implications
6. Review of literature
