About Speaker: Susan Snow Wadley, Professor Emerita at Syracuse University, USA; first studied at Delhi University in 1963 and did research on girl's education in a village then outside of Delhi. She completed her PhD in Anthropology at the University of Chicago focusing on the concept of Shakti, the power held by women in Hindu belief, as found in religious practices in a rural community in Uttar Pradesh. She has continued her connection to that community for more than 50 years, but more recently has focused on the Mithila painters of northern Bihar. In the fall of 2020, she curated an online exhibition of Mithila paintings about Covid-19 for the Syracuse University Art Museum.
