

Speaker

Shimon Edelman is a Professor of Psychology at Cornell University. He holds degrees in electrical engineering and in computer science and is interested in all aspects of mind, brain, behavior, and the human condition. At Cornell, he works on behavioral, neural, evolutionary, and computational aspects of language, vision, consciousness, and happiness. His monographs include "Computing the Mind," a textbook (2008); "The Happiness of Pursuit," not a self-help book (2012); "Beginnings," a psychological-philosophical science fiction, or psy-phi sci-fi, analysis (2014); and, most recently, "Life, Death, and Other Inconvenient Truths," an abecedary take on the human condition in 38 short chapters (2020). He has won several accolades such as the Levinson Prize in Mathematics and has been the director of the Cornell Cognitive Studies Program (2001-2004). He is also Associate Editor of Cognitive Sciences, Brain and Behaviour Sciences, among others.

Ramesh Mishra is a Professor of Cognitive Science at the Centre for Neural and Cognitive Sciences, School of Medical Sciences, University of Hyderabad, India. His current interests focus on visual attention, unconscious processing, bilingualism, cognitive control and individual differences in cognition. He is the author of '*Interaction Between Attention and Language Systems in Humans: A Cognitive Science Perspective*' and more recently '*Bilingualism and Cognitive Control*' (Springer Nature). He is also the Editor-in-Chief of the International Journal of Cultural Cognitive Science (Springer Nature) and is a fellow of the Psychonomic Society.
