The admissions for classes UKG, III to V and classes VII to IX for the academic year 2026-2027 are open.

Applications are invited for admission into classes UKG, III to V and classes VII to IX. Application forms can be obtained from the office of the UoH Campus school from 01.06.2026 on payment of Rs.400/- on all working days from 11.00 am to 2 p.m. Candidates belonging to SC/ST (providing proof) have to pay only Rs.200/- for application form. Application fee has to be paid by way of challan in SBI, HCU Branch.

Duly filled in application form, along with the following documents, has to be submitted on or before **10.06.2026** at the UoH Campus School office on all working days from 11A.M. to 2P.M.

1. Birth certificate & Aadhar cards of parents and the candidate
2. Community/Caste certificate in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates.
3. Progress report of the academic year 2025-26.

Criteria for Admission

Age: To seek admission the following is the age criteria




Vacancies are very limited and will be filled based on the performance and obtaining minimum qualifying mark in each subject in the entrance exam and interaction.

Entrance Examination will be held on 16.06.2026 in the school **at 10AM, candidate must report to the school at 9AM with an original identity proof.** Shortlisted candidates will be called for interaction on 20.06.2026. List of selected candidates will be displayed on or before 25.06.2026, in the notice board of the school office. Last date for payment of fee to complete admission formalities will be on or before 29.06.2026.

Note:1. Admissions are closed for Classes LKG, I, II and VI

3. Entrance question paper will be from the CBSE syllabus of the last class studied by the student (Ex. LKG syllabus for UKG admission, II class syllabus for class III admission and so on...)
4. Details of the subjects, qualifying marks and other details can be found in Annex -A.
5. In all admission related matters the decision of SMC is final and binding on all.
6. Admission is purely on merit basis.
7. The school reserves the right to fill or not to fill the vacancies /cancel/modify the notification as deemed fit and binding on all.

METHOD OF ADMISSION

Class UKG:

- (i) There shall be an admission test/interactive session of 30 marks.
 - (ii) All the eligible candidates shall be called for an admission test/interactive session, with the teacher, along with the parent, to ascertain the students' minimum required mental ability skills, motor skills etc.
 - (iii) Admission shall be granted in the sequence of priority categories, on the basis of the mental abilities, motor skills as ascertained in the admission test/interactive session.
 - (iv) Timings of admission test is 10 AM to 11AM
- Mere calling/appearing for an interactive session will not confer a right to admission.

CLASSES I TO IX

For admission to Classes I to IX, an admission test and an interactive session shall be conducted.

(a) Classes I & II

There will be only one paper of admission test of 90 minutes duration of 60 marks comprising Hindi/Telugu, English, Maths, EVS each of 15marks and an interactive session.

Timings of admission test is 10 AM to 11:30AM

(b) Classes III to V

There will be only one paper of admission test of 2½hour duration of 80 marks comprising Hindi/Telugu, English, Maths and Science each of 20 marks and an interactive session.

Timings of admission test is 10 AM to 12.30PM

(c) Classes VI to X

There will be only one paper of admission test of 3-hour duration of 100 marks comprising Hindi/Telugu, English, Maths and Science each of 25 marks and an interactive session.

Timings of admission test is 10 AM to 1 PM

- (i) Candidates must secure 33% marks in aggregate to qualify. Mere qualifying in the admission test shall not confer a right to admission. It is mandatory for a candidate to perform well in the interactive session to be considered for admission. A merit list will be prepared for each category of priority and admission shall be granted in the sequence of priority categories, in the order of merit.

In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in aggregate of all subjects, the inter-se merit of such candidates may be determined as follows:

- a. Candidates obtaining higher marks in Maths will get precedence in admission.
- b. If two or more candidates have got the same marks in Maths, then the candidates securing higher marks in Maths and English taken together will get precedence over the others.
- c. In case of a tie between two or more candidates obtaining same marks in Maths and English taken together,
 - (i) the student with a sibling in the school will be given precedence over the other,
 - (ii) In the absence of a sibling, the student older in age as per the date of birth will be given precedence over the other.
